

One-Time Behavioral Health Consultation Service for PCP's

AHCCCS Health plan members are able to receive psychotropic medication management through their PCP for diagnoses of depression, anxiety, and ADHD. The PCP may request, through the Regional Behavioral Health Authority (RBHA), a one-time psychiatric consultation, information of a general nature and/or request that a psychiatrist provide a face-to-face consultation with the patient for diagnostic purposes and medication recommendations. Requests for consultation may include a review of medication or occur when the PCP has a need for direction regarding the psychiatric status of a member. Please direct your requests to the appropriate RBHA by county. Additional information below.
