## Call for Health Choice Primary Care Providers to conduct MAT Services in 2018

## Dear Provider:

Health Choice Arizona (Health Choice), following the guidance of AHCCCS, is implementing a Primary Care Provider (PCP) network of clinicians credentialed to provide Health Choice members with medication-assisted treatment (MAT) for opioid use disorder (OUD). You were identified as a Health Choice PCP that may be interested in providing medication-assisted treatment (MAT) for opioid use disorder (OUD) to our members.

Health Choice will make prescribing of FDA-approved medications for OUD available *to MAT PCPs*, which can be used in conjunction with psychological and behavioral therapies for Health Choice members.

Medications available for PCPs credentialed with Health Choice to provide MAT Services include:

- 'Preferred Drugs': NALOXONE injection, NALTREXONE oral, NARCAN Nasal, SUBOXONE sublingual, VIVITROL IM
- Drugs with Prior Authorization require use of "Preferred Drugs' first and include: BUNAVAIL Buccal, BUPRENORPHINE sublingual, BUPRENORPHINE-NALOXONE sublingual, PROBUPHINE implant, ZUBSOLV sublingual
